


E-LYMPICS

On the 6th to 7th of February, the Interact Club of WMSKL(I) held their Virtual Funding Project: E-lympics. E-lympics is an E-sports tournament centered around the game Valorant. Valorant was chosen as it was a popular game amongst Wesleyans at the time. The event was organised by the Funding Director Interactor Daryl Yong Ka Wei, Assistant Funding Director Interactor Lim Yi Xuan, and I.U. Director Interactor Kenji Liew.

The registration and running of E-lympics were done completely online to adhere to the Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs).

E-lympics saw the participation of a total of 21 teams. Each team had 5 players, comprising of current WMSKL(I) students, WMSKL(I) alumni, as well as students from other schools (with at least 2 Wesleyans in their team). The Valorant matches were live-streamed on the Interact Club of WMSKLI's YouTube channel. During the event, Interactors, Wesley alumni and Wesleyans were invited to give commentary on the matches.

Each member of the champion team that won the E-lympics tournament received a set of wireless headphones. Every member of the first runner up team received a wireless mouse. We humbly thank all the students who supported our event, and we would like to thank the members and commentators for their hard work.


The Library Prefects were split into groups and had to succeed in completing five levels of challenges to obtain the Meeting ID and password to a Zoom Meeting where safety beckoned.

JOMSUKAN JOMSUKAN VIRTUAL RUN

From the 8th to 21st February 2021, Wesley Methodist School Kuala Lumpur International held its first ever Virtual Run entitled "JomSukan Virtual Run". A series of events that would replace the annual school Cross Country and Sports Day. Every month, a new run will be launched to all students, teachers and parents, which would contribute points to each sports house that will accumulate till the end of the year.

In the month of February JomSukan organized two Virtual Runs, the KL Virtual Run 2021 and the OX Virtual Run 2021. Registration was open from the 1st to the 7th of February and the official run commenced on the 8th of February. Participants could choose to enter the run under the 5KM, 10KM, 15KM, 21KM or 42KM categories. Given 2 weeks to complete their selected distance, participants were allowed to accumulate the total distance within the 2 weeks, recording each run through fitness apps which they would use to submit their results. The sooner the results were submitted, the higher chance the student could win and contribute more towards their sports house.


